200-VA * (10 min. serious)	Asbestos Awareness Exposure Gives OSHA guidelines concerning asbestos exposure and removal. Shows danger signs to look for that could be caused by asbestos.
200-VB (9 min. serious)	HAZCOM: Training Describes physical & health hazards posed by chemicals. Gives a list of symptoms of overexposure to chemicals & ways to avoid or reduce chemical exposure.
200-VBS * (12 min. serious)	Hazardous Waste and Chemicals - Spanish Discusses basic hazardous waste regulations, chemical labeling, working with hazardous materials and working safely with solvents. (Excellent for orientation and for updating experienced employees.)
200-VC (17 min. serious)	OSHA - Hazard Communication Standards Gives an in-depth view of OSHA's new inspection criteria.
200-VD (10 min. humorous)	Lead Awareness Uses a game show format with a series of questions and answers to educate viewers on lead poisoning.
200-VE * (10 min. serious)	HAZCOM - Right to Know: Nursing Discusses health and chemical hazards, use of PPE and MSDS. Lots of good information.
200-VES * (10 min. serious)	HAZCOM - Right to Know - Spanish Covers: 1) Hazardous material definition and OSHA safety standards 2) Labels: info on them, following instructions 3) MSDS: section-by-section info 4) Labeling new containers, using labeled materials.
200-VF * (7 min. serious)	Silicosis Discusses which jobs have silica exposure, causes of silicosis and preventive measures that can be taken to reduce the risk.
200-VG (5 min. serious)	Industrial Hygiene for Safety Gives a brief overview of Industrial Hygiene in the workplace.

200-VH * (5 min. serious)	Danger: Benzene Discusses hazards and gives safety tips for working around or with Benzene. Lists correct type of PPE to use.
200-VI * (14 min. serious)	Informed and Safe - Implementing HazCom Stresses proper training and the importance of written programs. Covers MSDS, labels and what is needed to pass OSHA HazCom Inspections.
200-VJ * (6 min. serious)	Hazard Communications Explains clearly how to read and use a MSDS sheet and chemical labels; touches on the responsible use of chemicals.
200-VJS * (6 min. serious)	Hazard Communications - Spanish Spanish version of 200-VJ
200-VK * (7 min. serious)	Material Safety Data Sheets Covers how to use and read a MSDS. Shows and goes over an actual MSDS.
200-VL * (14 min. serious)	Flammable Chemicals Shows the difference between flammable, combustible, and explosive chemicals and how to use them safely. Stresses the use of MSDS & proper storage and handling of chemicals.
200-VLS * (14 min. serious)	Flammable Chemicals - Spanish Spanish version of 200-VL
200-VM * (17 min. serious)	How to Handle Corrosives Gives suggested guidelines to handling corrosives.
200-VN * (17 min. serious)	HazMat Training - Packaging/Marking Discusses the proper packaging and marking procedures of hazardous materials. Covers general packaging requirements in non bulk and bulk packaging.
200-VO * (25 min. serious)	HM-126F HazMat Training Explains what RSPA regulation calls for and what must be done to comply with training regulations. Shows training areas and what information must be included for training.
200-VP * (20 min. serious)	Chemical Biological Preparedness - The New Threat Covers the essential procedures for preventing, identifying and responding to bio/chemical threats. Discusses the potential chemical and biological weapons, including: chlorine, phosgene, mustard gas, nerve gas, VX, Sarin, smallpox, anthrax, and botulin.
